Regulation 2.003 Standards of Student Progress

- (1) Florida Atlantic University (FAU) standards of student progress are defined in the official <u>University Catalog</u>. The catalog year determines the set of academic requirements that must be fulfilled for graduation. A student continuously enrolled at FAU may be awarded a degree by satisfying the degree requirements defined in any catalog in effect during the period of continuous enrollment leading up to graduation. Students must follow a single catalog to meet graduation requirements, not a combination of catalogs.
